## About the E-Rate Program

Created by Congress as part of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, the E-Rate program provides eligible public and private K-12 schools and public libraries in the United States with discounts for eligible services and products such as Internet access, telecommunications, basic network security, and certain types of network infrastructure. E-Rate discounts may range from 20 percent to 90 percent for eligible solutions, depending on economic need and location (urban or rural). Approximately \$2.25 billion is annually available for disbursement among E-Rate applicants.
